## The Project

Cyprus Dysmenorrhea (CypDy) Project is a bi-communal research study on dysmenorrhea funded by the European Union (EuropeAid/173620/DH/ACT/CY), and lead by Dr. Lysia Demetriou from FemHealth and Dr. Nilufer Rahmioglu from KISAD. The purpose of this study is to explore the symptoms, effects on quality of life and awareness of dysmenorrhea in menstruating individuals in Cyprus. Additionally, it will explore potential associations between dysmenorrhea symptoms and vitamin D levels in menstruating adolescent and pre-menopausal individuals.

## The Role

- Conduct patient screenings, enrolment, and follow-ups per protocol
- Keep recruitment records including consent forms and study documents
- Manage study and patient calendars and schedules
- Ensure compliance with study protocols, regulatory requirements, and internal policies
